Study of the inter-relationship of politics and emotions in areas where these multidisciplinary phenomena play a role such as education, psychology, biology, social sciences, language teaching, computer sciences, language acquisition and narrative inquiry. This research seminar aims to pay special attention to questions of ethics that emerge from the rapid expanding area of large language models and artificial intelligence systems aligned with debates on the anthropocene. Discussions will be undertaken on topics such as disinformation, chatbots, emotional manipulation, deepfakes, mental illness, climate change, language education. We look towards other cosmologies that may bring forth other narratives for languaging our future in the planet. This seminar is part of an international endeavour and aims at uniting different scholars in the field through the use of digital communication.

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
